Let us pray:



BEGINNING OF 2025 SCHOOL YEAR & TESTING

This year the children in **Years 1 & 2** will be again required to book in for numeracy testing on either Wednesday January 29 or Thursday January 30.

Attached to today's newsletter is the booking details for Years 1 & 2 only.

The numeracy & literacy testing for children in **Years 3-6** will be different than in previous years.

- All children whose surname begins with A-K will be required to attend school from 9:00am - 11:30am on Wednesday January 29.
- All children whose surname begins with L-Z will be required to attend school from 9:00am - 11:30am on Thursday January 30.

There is no need to book the children in for these sessions. They are expected to attend on the days indicated.

The change is due to a number of different tests being introduced which will provide more relevant data on the children's strengths and challenges.

We thank you in advance for your support of this change as the school makes these changes to achieve even better outcomes for the children.

PREP INFORMATION EVENING & ORIENTATION

This week we welcomed the 2025 Prep children who had the first of their 3 days of orientation. It was great to see the energy and enthusiasm they brought with them.
